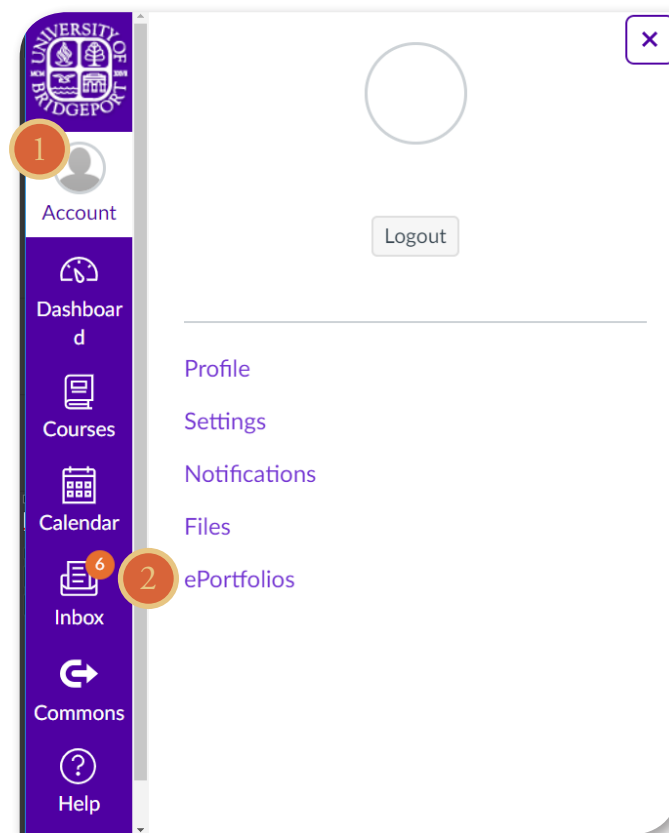


How do I make my ePortfolio public as a student?

Public ePortfolios allow anyone with the URL to view your ePortfolio. Learn more about sharing a private ePortfolio.

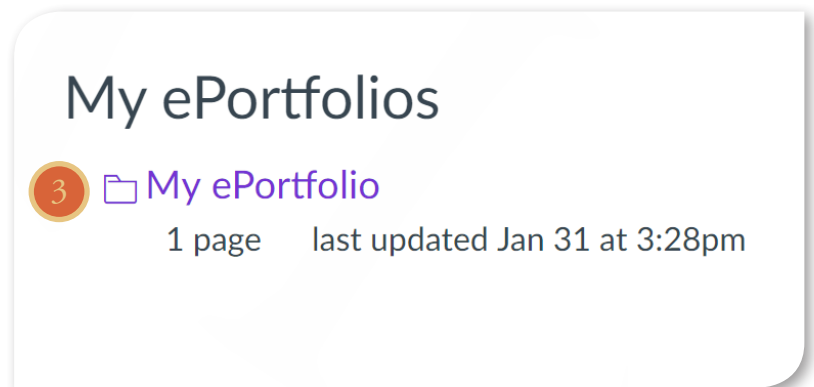
Open ePortfolios



In Global Navigation:

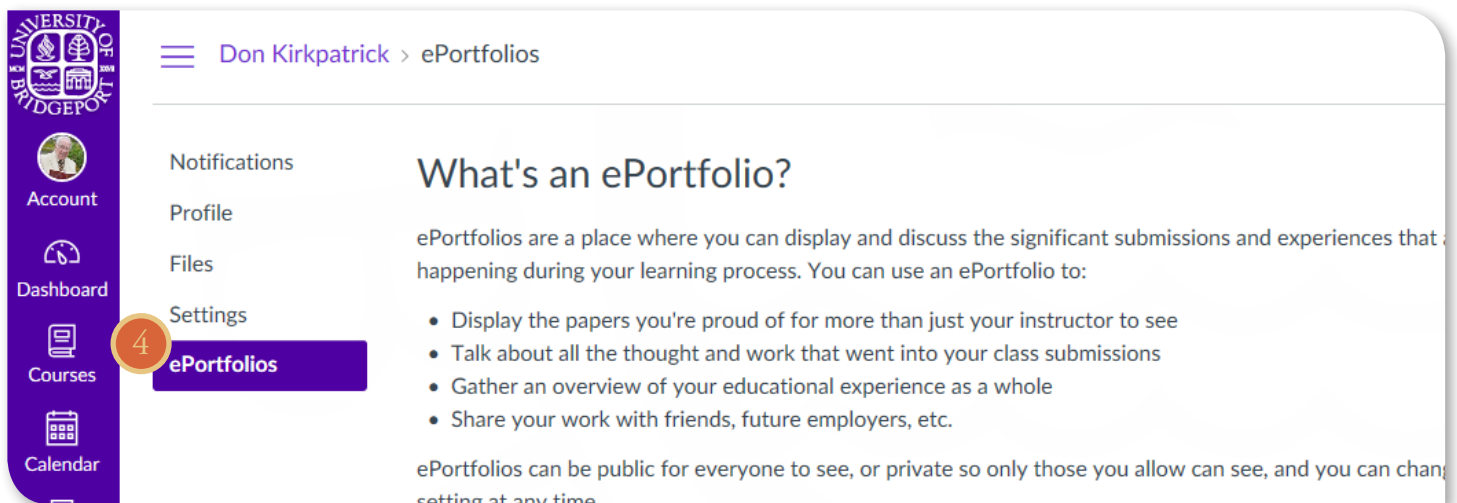
1. Click the [Account](#) link.
2. Click the [ePortfolios](#) link.

3. Click the title of the ePortfolio.


Open ePortfolio Settings



4. Click the [ePortfolio Settings](#) link to change the privacy settings on your ePortfolio.

Set Privacy

5. Click the **Make it Public** checkbox [1] and click the **Update ePortfolio** button [2] to save changes to your ePortfolio settings.



Your ePortfolio is Private

View Privacy

Your ePortfolio is Public

That means anyone who knows the address of your portfolio can view it. You can make your portfolio private by **changing your portfolio settings**.

6. By making your ePortfolio public, anybody who has the URL address to your ePortfolio can view its contents.
